

CAHON Young Investigator Award (YIA)

CAHON 2017 YIAs will be awarded to CAHON members who are physician-in-training or in early career development based on the scientific merit of their abstracts submitted to the 2017 ASCO meeting. Each CAHON YIA awardee will receive \$500 in support of expenses to attend the ASCO meeting. The research data associated with the YIA awards will be given priority consideration for publication in the Journal of Hematology & Oncology. The application deadline is 11:59pm Central Time on May 22th, 2017.

Eligibility for consideration of CAHON YIA:

- Being a CAHON member who is the first author or senior author of an abstract to be presented at the 2017 ASCO annual meeting

- Would attend the CAHON YIA award ceremony during the 2017 ASCO meeting

- Accepted 2017 ASCO abstract, abstract category (clinical or translation or others), presentation time
