

CAHON Young Investigator Award (YIA)

Six YIAs will be awarded to CAHON members who are physician-in-training or in early career development based on the scientific merit of their abstracts submitted to the 2014 ASCO meeting. In addition to award certificate, each CAHON YIA awardee will receive \$500 in support of expenses to attend ASCO meeting. The selected studies will be given priority for fast-track peer-review and publication in the CAHON official journal, *Journal of Hematology & Oncology* (www.jhoonline.org). The application deadline is 11:59pm Central Time on April 28, 2014.

Eligibility for consideration of CAHON YIA:

- Being a CAHON member who is the first author or senior author of an abstract to be presented at the 2014 ASCO annual meeting

- Being a trainee or within 10 years after fellowship training
